The speakers:

Dr Aiman Nariman Mohd Sulaiman is a Professor of Law at the Ahmad Ibrahim Kulliyah of Laws (AIKOL), International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) and has been a faculty member since graduating from IIUM in 1993 with a First Class (Hons) Degree.

She is currently a board member of the Listing Committee of Bursa Malaysia (2015-2018) having held the same position between 2008-2012. She is a Chairperson and director of IIUM Corporate Management Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of IIUM Holdings Sdn Bhd. She was also a member of audit and risk management committee of the International Islamic University Malaysia between 2010-2012 and 2015-2017.

She has conducted various training modules including programmes on behalf of SSM and the Malaysian Anti Corruption Academy, and many others. The topics that she speaks on are related to Board of Directors’ meetings, engagement with shareholders, directors’ accountability and capital raising.

She was a key figure in the Malaysian Corporate Law Reform Programme (2004–2008) and the recommendations have been included in the new Companies Act 2016.

Dr Mohsin Hingun is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law, International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). In his 30 years of teaching, he has taught the Law of Trust, Revenue Law, International Trade & Shipping Law, Securities Regulation and Corporate Law and Financial Services.

He joined the Law Faculty of the International Islamic University Malaysia in 1989 after completing his LLM in the UK and was called to the UK Bar as a member of Lincoln’s Inn. Between 1999 and 2008, he was attached to the Law School of the University of Mauritius and subsequently, he rejoined the Law Faculty of IIUM. He is the co-author of The Law of Trust published by Sweet & Maxwell and was also the editor of the IIUM Law Journal.
