Topics:

1. **The Security Offences (Special Measures) Act 2012** is an Act to provide for special measures relating to security offences for the purpose of maintaining public order and security and for connected matters. The Act replaced the 1960 Internal Security Act (Malaysia).
2. **The Prevention of Terrorism Act 2015** is an anti-terrorism law that was passed by the Government on 7 Apr 2015. It enables the Malaysian authorities to detain terror suspects without trial for a period of two years. POTA also does not allow any judicial reviews of detentions.
3. **Article 10 of the Federal Constitution of Malaysia** guarantees Malaysian citizens the right to freedom of speech, freedom of assembly and freedom of association.

Gobind Singh Deo s/o Karpal Singh is a prominent Malaysian lawyer and politician and the Member of Parliament for Puchong, Selangor. Gobind was admitted to the Malaysian Bar in 1996, a year after returning from Lincoln's Inn. He currently practices at Gobind Singh Deo & Co, KL.
