The Talk will deal with practical aspects relating to written and oral advocacy for the appellate courts but will not cover procedural aspects. It will focus on practical matters relating to advocacy and how one should approach the preparation and drafting of written submissions for appeals and oral advocacy before the appellate courts. The Talk will also invite participants to think of how to approach an appeal from the point of view of appellant and respondent. It will also cover practical insights into the manner in which counsel ought to prepare for oral arguments and to engage effectively with the appellate tribunal.

The Speaker:

Brendan Siva was admitted as an Advocate & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya in 1999. Brendan was Chairman of the Kuala Lumpur Bar Committee 2010/2012 and has been a member of the Bar Council for 7 terms. He has been an advocacy trainer since 2010 and has conducted advocacy training throughout Malaysia and in Hong Kong, South Africa, Singapore, United Kingdom, Australia and Ireland. Brendan is currently one of the Vice-Chairmen of the International Advocacy Training Council (IATC). He was also the Course Leader for the Advanced Appellate Advocacy Course in Kuala Lumpur in July 2016.
