Order and Prevention of Crime) Ordinance 1969, among others. He has conducted numerous workshops and sessions on human rights for lawyers and students. Previously, Yohendra was the Human Rights Education Coordinator for Amnesty International Malaysia from 2006 to 2008, and was a member of the Human Rights Commission of Malaysia (“SUHAKAM”)’s working group on human rights education in schools. He was also elected as the Asia-Pacific representative to Amnesty International’s Human Rights Education Coordinating Committee.
