The Speaker:

She has been practising as an Advocate & Solicitor for more than 33 years, specialising mainly in civil and family law cases and is a certified Mediator of the Bar Council’s Malaysian Mediation Centre. She was elected Chairperson of the Penang Bar Committee and Penang Bar Representative to Bar Council Malaysia for 2 terms respectively and is a current member of the Bar Council Family Law Committee.

Lalitha is also the current Vice-President of the Women’s Centre for Change (WCC), Penang and has been actively involved in various roles since it was formed in 1985, namely in law reform and advocacy work. She has been appointed as a Member of the Pardons Board of Penang for the past 3 terms.
