The speaker:

Dato' Varghese George graduated in 1974 from the University of Singapore with a degree in Law. He was in private practice as an Advocate & Solicitor for 35 years and was the Senior Partner of Messrs Zain & Co in Kuala Lumpur (specialising in civil, commercial, construction, land and administrative litigation and arbitration matters) before being appointed a Judicial Commissioner in Oct 2009.

He was subsequently elevated as a Judge of the High Court in Aug 2011 and thereafter as a Judge of the Court of Appeal in Oct 2013. He served as a Judge in Penang at the High Court from Jan 2011 to Sept 2013.

He retired from the Judiciary on 27 Jan 2017 at the Court of Appeal. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrator (FCIArb) and of the Malaysian Institute of Arbitrators (FMIArbs) and currently acts as Arbitrator, Adjudicator and Mediator in various disputes.
