This is an area of the law that is not often used by lawyers but which is nonetheless important as it would help to alleviate and overcome the problem of overcrowding in our Malaysian prisons. With a better understanding of this Act, it is hoped that legal practitioners will be able to better utilise the relevant legal provisions.
