Habib Rahman Bin Seeni Mohideen is a senior partner at EzriLaw Firm. He graduated with an LLB (Hons) degree from International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) and pursued his Master's Degree in Banking Law from the same institution. In his 32 years of practice, he has been involved in handling litigation matters involving civil and commercial disputes, debt recovery, employment and Syariah disputes. He has also drafted trust, wakaf and estate administration documents. He has appeared in the Civil and Syariah Subordinate Courts and High Courts, as well as Appellate Courts. He has also been actively involved as a Syarie Counsel in Penang since 1992.

He has developed a passion for Islamic Banking, especially from the perspective of a litigation lawyer which led to him writing the article "AFFIN BANK BHD v. ZULKIFLI ABDULLAH - SHARIAH PERSPECTIVE [2006] 3 MLJ I" which was published in the Malayan Law Journal (MLJ). The article was quoted and referred to in the judgment of MALAYSIAN BANKING BERHAD v. YA'AKUB BIN OKE (2007) 6 MLJ 389.

He was appointed and served as a member of the Syura Council of the state of Penang. Currently, he serves as the President of the Tribunal for Consumer Claims in Penang.
